FADE IN:

1. EXT. UNIVERSE

Rock fragments of stars flit through the cosmic UNIVERSE.

The pulsating SUN appears. It glows with bloody temperature and sizzles with emotion. You can see the rocky planets Mercury, Venus, Earth, and Mars; the asteroid belt; and the dwarf Ceres in it.

In addition, 160 moons are circling boldly. They are accompanied by billions of small bodies, including asteroids, comets, meteoroids, and interplanetary dust. There is chaos, rushing, and struggle here.

But the farther from this SOLAR SYSTEM, the less confusion there is. A bit farther, it grows a bit calmer as if another system appears.

Star debris glide toward the atmospheres of the new planets, burning themselves. The moons circulate one after another.

There are many different planets in the SUN'S NEIGHBORHOOD. They shine strongly with their light. This great place in the universe is teeming with life.

Small, bright bodies cling to a dominant planet — the biggest one here, it seems. There is a blue, luminous TERRA. It is circular and looks like a full O. It's so O mega.

As you draw closer to this Terra, the rush stops completely. Rock debris splashes into the atmosphere. Warm light spreads around. The black abyss ceases completely as a BLUE SHINE appears.

2. EXT. AIRY FIELDS/TERRA - DAWN

Warm BLUE controls the whole space. It seems a new day is beginning here.

The PEACE of nature extends over the AIRY FIELDS.

TERRA ANIMALS roam the tall grass in carefree joy. They sway freely and at the same time let out nice MURMURS.

3. EXT. DESCENT/TERRA - CONTINUOUS

Behind the airy fiels is a venerable lake — a surface of water as pure as a priceless diamond glistens from afar.

You draw closer and closer to the lake, all the way to the shore. Here is DECSENT — descent to the water.

4. EXT. PALACE/PROFUNDUM - CONTINUOUS

Below the surface of the WATER, deep down, the bluish space becomes more and more navy blue.

Immersion into the deep - PROFUNDUM.

Here: PROFUNDUM ANIMALS are moving freely from one place to another. Fish flow calmly with a bluish gaze.

More and more jellyfish, transparent creatures, are PULSING around, pushing off each other with their tiny tentacles.

Colorful creatures with bizarre shapes headed by stars also drift here. Some are TWITCHING enthusiastically, while others are SWAYING lazily.

In the dark depths, where the sun does not reach anymore and there is still life, a crystal PALACE is embedded at the very bottom.

5. INT. AUDIENCE/PALACE - DAY

AUDIENCE: the bluish mosaic floor dominates the spacious interior, which is enclosed with glass walls and a semicircular crystal vault. In the background is a platform with a venerable seat.

Behind the glass walls all around: bright beams of light pierce the black depths of the Profundum. The rays cut the environment in different directions and make the space take on a navy blue glow in these places.

To the walls of the auditorium, curious animals swim over from the depths and observe the thing inside:

Mature SACERDOS goes inside hastily. He is dressed in an ephod with a pectoral cross on his breast, and a fine linen tunic underneath that extends to the ground. He walks to the end of the interior.

On the platform sits MATER imperiously — the just, victorious, and humble Mother Earth, dressed in a chiton.

On her left side, next to the seat, is a twisted CANE with a sharp light emanating from it.

Sacerdos pauses in concentration before the few steps leading up to the podium.

SACERDOS

Hello, noble Lady.

He bows humbly.

Mater looks down kindly from above.

MATER

Terra has always circled the universe peacefully. The planets are not dangerous. Dangerous are the creatures that escape from them.

He straightens up in the seat and stares intensely ahead.

MATER

The big day is near. Very near and forthcoming it is.

The faithful servant asks with the first sweat on his temple:

SACERDOS

Mater, what do you see?

Mother Earth strongly FOCUSES.

MATER

I see...far far away, the planet is being destroyed...lack of life...I feel several dozen of those there manage to escape...they move on the fragments of stars...

SACERDOS

What else, my Lady?

MATER

I feel one big star...In addition, I can sense several dozen smaller ones around and a few more tiny debris.

Sacerdos takes a step toward the podium with interest.
